To apply, send camp registration form and the \$80 deposit with this application to your County Extension Office. Please answer all questions on this form as best you can. The registration, deposit and scholarship application should be received by Extension as soon as possible as camper spaces cannot be reserved without payment. Space is limited! The deposit is not refundable after June 15. Priority may be given to children who have not previously received a 4-H Camp scholarship.


